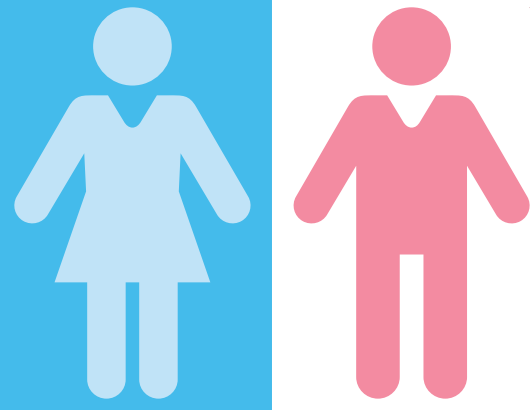

1 major achievement of member organization for patient community



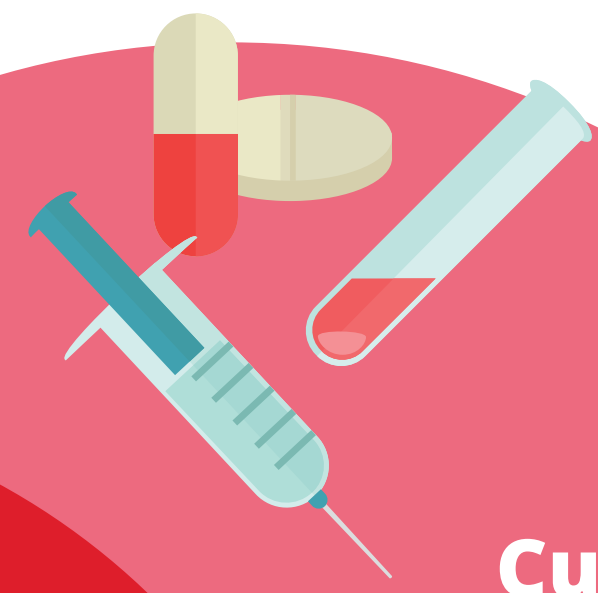
**The most important thing our NMO achieved for us was to get access to medication in our country to stop or prevent crisis as well as the possibility to self administer them.**
